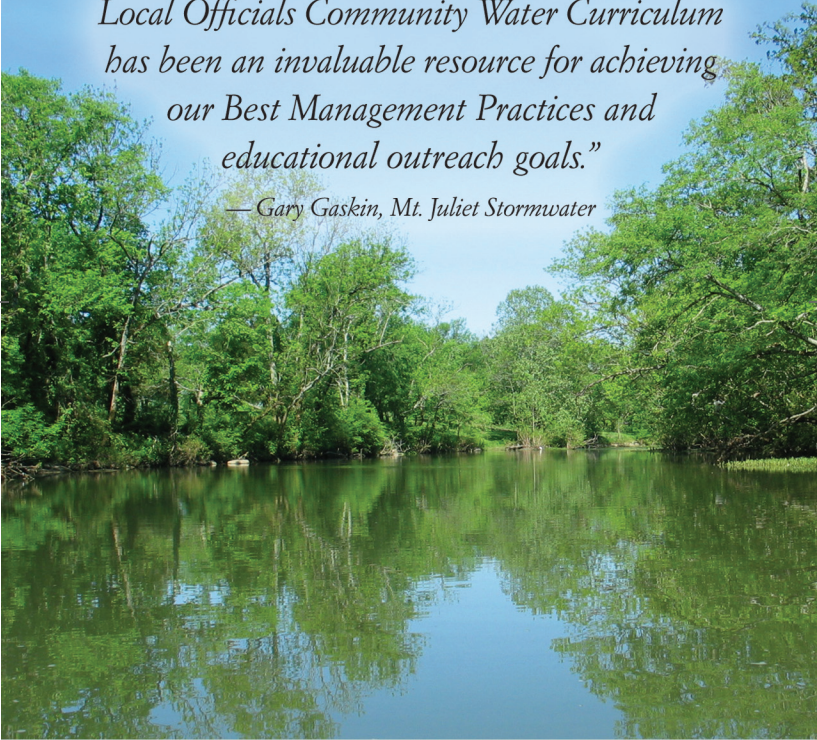




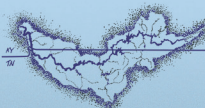

- Stream Health

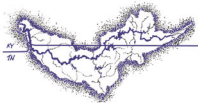
